Mission Experiences in Senegal with Mary Balson

Tuesday, October 8th at 6:30 pm

Pastor Mary Balson will be sharing insights about each of the four Mission trips she has taken to Senegal, Africa.

Pastor Balson has been to Africa three times as part of a medical mission team and on her most recent trip in January of 2019, she served as an advocate for the mission work that is being carried on in Senegal.

Her lecture will give guest a visual experience of life in Senegal's small towns, large cities, and rural areas. As well as pictures of giraffes, zebras, etc. taken at the Bandia Game Preserve, photos taken on Goree Island the site where slaves were exported to the New World, and a viewing of the famous Pike Lake. Also include in the presentation will be photos taken at wellness clinics, the women's prison, the nutrition center, a women's skill center, and the on-going agriculture project.
