

Campbellsport Public Library - Adventure Pass Policy

The Campbellsport Library offers a library of things, which is a collection of circulating, non-traditional items. One of those items is the Adventure Pass(es).

The following rules apply to the Adventure Pass(es):

- To check out a pass you must present a current, valid library card in good standing from a library in the Winnefox Library System
- The borrower must be at least 18 years of age to check out an Adventure Pass.
- A household may borrow only one Adventure Pass at a time.
 - *The exception to this rule is the Manitowoc Maritime Museum pass and the Farm Discovery pass may be checked out together.*
- If a household is going on vacation and would like to extend the use of their pass beyond the three days, it is up to the discretion of the director to grant or deny a time extension.
- A household may borrow a particular venue pass no more than once per month
- Adventure passes circulate for varied assigned periods and are not renewable.
- The patron who checks out the pass must be a physically present party member at the venue during the use of the pass.
- Passes must be picked up and returned at the front desk; no book drop returns.
- The venue, followed by the library, reserves the right to determine the rules, regulations, and restrictions governing the use of its passes.
- It is the borrower's responsibility to contact the venue for information, hours of operation, parking and/or directions. The venue reserves the right to determine the rules, regulations and restrictions governing the use of its passes.
- In order to check out a pass, the patron must submit a signed copy of Library of Things Lending Policy Agreement, which will act as acknowledgement of understanding and agreement to comply with the guidelines listed in the policy.
- The library reserves the right to limit the use of passes for individuals or families in the case of abuse as determined by the director, which may be appealed in writing to the Library Board
- Overdue fines begin at \$5.00 a day. Any pass not returned within one week of its due date shall be considered stolen. The normal overdue policy will not apply, the case may be forwarded to the Campbellsport Police Department, and the patron will be charged the replacement cost of the pass.
- Damage or replacement costs vary per pass and are as follows:
 - Bookworm Gardens-\$100
 - Children's Museum-Fond du Lac / Above and Beyond Museum-\$250
 - Farm Wisconsin Discovery Center-\$100
 - Milwaukee Art Museum- \$150 per pass (4 passes total \$600)
 - Milwaukee Zoo- \$500 per pass (2 passes total \$1000)
 - Wisconsin Historical Society -\$500
 - Wisconsin Maritime Museum (Manitowoc) -\$120

Any requested exceptions or extensions on checkouts and all policies are under the discretion of the library director and the library board and are subject to change.

Loan Details for Bookworm Gardens

- Circulates for 3 business days
- Admission for 2 adults and an unlimited amount of children from the same household. Any attendees outside of that parameter will be expected to pay applicable admission prices.
- Pass is Valid only at Bookworm Gardens
- Not valid for special event admission see their website for details

Loan Details for Children's Museum of Fond du Lac and Above and Beyond Children's Museum

- Circulates for 3 business days
- The family Adventure Pass is good at both the Children's Museum of Fond du Lac and the Above & Beyond Children's Museum in Sheboygan
- The pass allows entry for all the members of a family within a household (this may include grandparents)
- Parking is free for all at the Fond du Lac Museum. If using the Pass at the Above and Beyond Children's Museum, please be aware that parking is metered.
- The Museum does not have a gift shop
- The children's museum of Fond du Lac is located a block from Lakeside Park, a 147 Acre public area that has trails, playgrounds, grilling stations and restrooms
- It is the borrower's responsibility to contact the venue for information, hours of operation, parking and/or directions. The venue reserves the right to determine the rules, regulations and restrictions governing the use of its passes.

Loan Details for Farm Wisconsin Discovery Center

- Circulates for 3 business days
- Entry for 2 adults and up to 4 children (ages 3-18) of same household. Children under 3 are free.
- NO EXTRA DISCOUNTS (no discount for shops or convention center)
- Pass must be left at the front desk while in the museum and picked up when exiting the facility.
- Parking is free for all.
- May be checked out concurrently with the Manitowoc Maritime Museum Pass

Loan Details for Milwaukee Art Museum

- Circulates for 3 business days
- 4 passes, each pass good for 4 adults and all children in a household under 18. Children 12 and under are always free.
- Use the QR code on the back of the card to get a 20% discount on parking at the Museum Center parking garages or Calatrava Underground Parking.
- 10% discount in the museum store and café
- Reciprocity at institutions nationwide. Check <https://mam.org/membership/reciprocity> for a list.

- Circulates for 3 business days
- Admission for up to 8 guests and one vehicle per card (2 Cards available) families may only check out one card at a time
- 10% Discount in the Milwaukee County Zoo Gift Shops
- Discounted/ Free Admission to more than 150 other zoos and aquariums

Loan Details for Wisconsin Historical Society

- Circulates for up to 1 week (though we request that the pass be returned sooner if possible).
- The pass includes the admission for two adults and children in the household under 18.

Loan Details for Wisconsin Maritime Museum - Manitowoc

- Circulates for 3 business days
- Admission for 2 adults and up to 4 children ages 3-18. Children aged 2 and under are FREE. Add additional children for \$5 each, admission grants access to the museum and to the submarine the USS Cobia.
- Free parking is available on the west, north and east sides of the Museum building. There is also on-street parking available.
- May be checked out concurrently with the Farm Discovery Pass
